

Follow the step by step instructions below on how to make a template of bay window.

The example below is a bay window which has 5 angles. As the angles are fairly shallow (<24 degrees) a curved radiator can be put in this bay instead of a 5 angled radiator. (cost effective)



Using light weight paper eg Lining paper or wallpaper lay the piece of paper on the floor and overlap the edges onto either the skirting board or the wall and fold the paper up. As illustrated below.

Note : if you don't have one long piece of paper then you can selotape smaller pieces together.



Starting from one corner cut the folded mark using a Stanley knife.

Once you have done this it should like something like this



Once the template has been cut lay the paper against either the skirting board or wall and ensure that you have an accurate cutout.

Write the following details on the template

Radiator brand :

Length and height of radiator

The fabrication required eg. Curved , Curved with grill, 2 angles

Where the template was taken from : Wall or Skirting board. If it was taken against the skirting board then please write the approx thickness of the skirting board.
